6. A written format/direction /continuity of Assembly is being worked on.
7. Effort will be done to keep Assembly costs as reasonable as possible.
8. Written proactive efforts will be encouraged by WGIPPA leadership in regard to issues effecting conservation and the parks.
9. Dale Gillespie has been authorized to create a new website.
10. Work with other peace programs will be done through the Peace Park Fellowship.
11. Invitations to the surrounding public as facilities dictate.
12. Increased District Governors' expectations to be involved with WGIPPA program.
13. Meet with Park Superintendents annually and include them in Assembly breakout sessions.
14. Meeting of WGIPPA Assembly may be held outside the park within 30-40 minutes of the parks.
15. More effort to keep park staff involved and informed of WGIPPA agenda and purposes.
16. Solicit a yearly project that WGIPPA will fund and complete.
17. There will be a yearly spring planning meeting rotated between the participating districts.
